Student Agreement for Camp Participants

Please put your initials on each space indicating that you understand and agree to each listed ISP policy. Parents must also write their initials if the applicant is under 18 years old.

STUDENT'S INITIALS and PARENT'S INITIALS (if student is under age 18):

- 1. I understand that by participating in the ISP Camp Program, I am expected to and will attend all daily classes and activities. I will participate in all classes and activities to the best of my ability. _____
- 2. During daily classes and activities, I agree to respect and to listen to my instructors and chaperones. I understand that during camp I will be under the supervision of class instructors, chaperones, and ISP staff. _____
- 3. I understand that my host will provide me with breakfast and dinner. Sometimes, I will have to prepare some of my own meals. With some programs, my host will also provide me with a lunch to take to school. My program leader will tell me if my program includes lunches. I will try to eat the meals my host provides me. I will not eat in my bedroom. _____
- 4. I understand that my host family has the right to set a reasonable curfew and if I am under 18 years old, I will have to abide by the local curfew laws. This is for my own safety. _____
- 5. Not all hosts can provide Internet access. In some cases, I might be able to use my host's computer and Internet but I must ask permission first. _____
- 6. If I share a host family with my classmate, I promise to speak English around my host family and will try to participate in daily conversations with my host. _____
- 7. America is a rich melting pot of people from many cultures and countries. I understand that my host family most likely will not be Caucasian. _____
- 8. I acknowledge that I am applying for a host family program. I accept that there is no perfect host family and agree to do my best to integrate with my host family's life. I understand that I will be considered a family member. Accordingly, my bedroom door will have a lock on the inside but not the outside. _____
- 9. I will bring a calling card to phone home during my stay and will not charge any calls to my host family. I will ask permission to use the host's phone before I make a call and will let my family know to only call me at my host family's home until 9 pm each night. _____
- 10. Each day, I will leave my bedroom neat and clean and also tidy my bathroom. I will make my bed each morning and help my host with normal household chores. I will wash my own clothes and will ask my host how to use the laundry facilities. At the end of the program, I will leave my bedroom and bathroom as I found it on the first day I arrived. I will thank my host family when I leave. I will take one shower per day no longer than ten minutes in length. _____
- 11. I agree to take good care of my host family's possessions, and to be financially responsible for the costs of any repairs associated with my negligence. I will be responsible for paying for any entrance fees for excursions that my host family takes me to. These might include going to amusement parks, movies, sporting events, etc. _____
- 12. I agree not to smoke in or around my host family's home. I will not engage in any illegal activities, including but not limited to the use of drugs or alcohol. _____
- 13. Warranties. I warrant that the information provided on my application is true and correct, I am not a sex offender, and I have not been convicted of any crime. _____
- 14. Limitation of Liability. IN NO EVENT SHALL ISP HAVE ANY LIABILITY TO ANY STUDENT FOR ANY INDIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, HOWEVER CAUSED, AND UNDER ANY THEORY OF LIABILITY, WHETHER OR NOT ISP HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES. FURTHER, ISP SHALL NOT BE NAMED AS A PARTY, CALLED AS A WITNESS, OR SERVED DISCOVERY REQUESTS IN ANY DISPUTE BETWEEN STUDENTS AND HOSTS. _____
- 15. Indemnification. I understand that hosts are not ISP's employees or agents, and that ISP has no constructive control of hosts' behavior. I understand that the information provided by ISP about my host family is not a perfect predictor of how my host family will act in the future. I understand that ISP cannot control or guarantee the behavior of host families. I assume all risks associated with injury or loss arising from my host family's behavior and/or on any excursions. I release ISP of any liability for any claim of injury, death, property damage, or other loss. I will not institute a claim against ISP and its vendors/subcontractors and will release and hold ISP forever harmless for any and all claims. _____
- 16. Governing Law. The parties agree to file any dispute regarding this Agreement in Santa Clara County, California Superior Court, and that any case will be determined using California law. _____

17. I understand that I may be asked to leave the program immediately if my behavior at camp and/or with my host family is rude or _____
offensive to others. At that time, I must return immediately to my home country.
